








ENGINE



"JEEP" TORNADO-OHC ENGINE. The biggest automotive engineering news of 1962 was the announcement of the 'Jeep' TORNADO-OHC engine . . . biggest 6 of 62. With its exclusive overhead cam design, "Tufftrided" crankshaft, spheroidal combustion chambers, ventilated crankcase and extra large valves, the TORNADO-OHC has yet to be matched by any competitive automotive manufacturer. It's the powerful good friend of every 'Jeep' Wagoneer owner.

ENGINE DETAIL. The TORNADO-OHC 6-cylinder engine produces 210 lbs. ft. of torque @ 1,750 R.P.M., 140 H.P. @ 4,000 R.P.M., with 230.5 cu. in. displacement and 8.5:1 compression ratio.

OVERHEAD CAM DESIGN. The only American made automotive engine with overhead cam design, the TORNADO-OHC has fewer moving parts, therefore requires less maintenance and has less chance of mechanical failure than conventional-design engines. Horsepower is properly applied so that the TORNADO delivers peak performance thigher torque at lower R.P.M.), to give you longer engine life and lower maintenance costs. Designed for economy, the TORNADO-OHC has lower fuel consumption while using regular gas.


